Renewal of registration for occupational therapists due soon

The Occupational Therapy Board of Australia (the Board) announced today that the 2013 renewal of registration campaign for occupational therapists is now open.

Over 14,900 occupational therapists with general or non-practising registration are due to renew their registration with the Board by 30 November.

Last year over 90 per cent of all health practitioner registration renewals due by 30 November were submitted online.

'This was a fantastic result and it shows how quick and easy online renewal is,' Occupational Therapy Board Chair Dr Mary Russell said.

Anyone who experiences difficulties using the online renewal service can phone the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) Customer Service Team on 1300 419 495 and a team member will talk them through the process.

Dr Russell reminded occupational therapists to carefully read the Occupational Therapy Board's registration standards which specify the requirements for practice before applying for renewal of their registration.

'Make sure you understand the declarations you are required to make about meeting the Board's registration standards,' she said.

'You could be asked to give information in support of your declarations so it's important to know what the requirements are for registration to practise.'

AHPRA, on behalf of the Board, is sending out a series of reminders to practitioners with a registered email address.

It is important that occupational therapists make sure AHPRA has their current contact information so they don't miss future email and hard copy reminders to renew.

To update contact details using AHPRA's secure online services, occupational therapists can visit <u>www.ahpra.gov.au</u>:

- go to the bottom of the home page
- click on Update Contact Details under Services for Practitioners
- use their user ID and secure password, and
- follow the prompts.

Under the National Law¹, all registered occupational therapists are responsible for renewing their registration on time each year.
