Adequate programs of study - qualifications for registration

In accordance with Section 53(b) of the National Law individuals are qualified for general registration if they hold a qualification the Occupational Therapy Board of Australia considers substantially equivalent, or based on similar competencies, to an approved qualification.

Note: National Law refers to *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law* as in force in each State and Territory.

Any programs or courses not listed will be individually assessed. If the assessment indicates the program / course meets the requirements, it will be added to the list.
